

CALL FOR PAPERS FROM THE IASA 4<sup>TH</sup> WORLD CONGRESS:  
DECODING AMERICAN CULTURES IN THE GLOBAL CONTEXT

Presenters at the IASA 4<sup>th</sup> World Congress are cordially invited to submit a paper based on their presentation for publication in a volume of selected proceedings. This invitation is also extended to those whose paper proposal was accepted but who were not able to attend.

Submissions will be subjected to peer review by the editors and advisory editors.

#### Deadline

All papers must be submitted by 30 April, 2010. Submissions after this date will not be considered.

#### Review procedure

- Editors initially review all papers to ensure that they comply with the Proceedings' guidelines. Those papers considered for publication are subsequently subject to blind review.
- These reviewers will receive a copy of your manuscript without any identifying names.
- Articles are accepted on the basis of both the peer review and the final judgment of the Proceedings editors. Evaluation should be completed by 31 August, 2010. Notification will follow shortly thereafter and readers' reports forwarded to contributors.
- A date for the final submission of copy for publication will be set after a publisher has been secured and contributors will be given details of the format of text, graphics and data that the publisher requires. At that stage, contributors will be asked to reformat their papers in accordance with the publisher's guidelines before sending in the final version.

#### Guidelines for submission of papers

For all submissions, please prepare the following materials:

1. Contact details (name, address, telephone, fax, email), paper title, and author name(s) with institutional affiliation.
2. An abstract (150 words absolute maximum) : longer abstracts will result in the paper being rejected.
3. A short biography (75 words maximum) for each contributor.
4. One copy of the manuscript with all names and identifying information removed. This copy will be forwarded to blind reviewers.
5. One copy of the manuscript with all graphics, charts, and tables included and with author's name and affiliation included.
6. If you have images, charts and tables, please also send these in a separate file. (For those papers accepted for publication, contributors will be required to seek permission for any copyrighted material and provide a copy of the permission to the editors).
7. Manuscripts should be in 12 point font throughout (except within tables), paginated, double-spaced and with one-inch (2.5 cm) wide margins all round.
8. All materials should be sent electronically in English in .doc or .docx or .rtf format. PDF files will not be accepted. Images may be sent as .jpeg or .gif files. Address to: [Maureen.montgomery@canterbury.ac.nz](mailto:Maureen.montgomery@canterbury.ac.nz)

Word Length: 5-6,000 words
